ARTICLE ONE

The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE EIGHT

In the event of the dissolution of this corporation for any reason whatsoever, the plan providing for the distribution of assets during the process of such dissolution shall be as follows:

- (a) All liabilities and obligations of this corporation shall be paid, satisfied and discharged, and in case its property and assets are not sufficient to satisfy or discharge all of the corporation's liabilities and obligations, the corporation shall apply them so far as they will go to the just and equitable payment of the liabilities and obligations;
- (b) Any assets held by the corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer or conveyance, which conditions occur by reason of the dissolution, shall be returned, transferred or conveyed in accordance with such requirements;
- (c) Any and all other assets of this corporation, upon its dissolution for any reason, which shall remain on hand after final audit of the books shall revert to another organization of like character and purpose; or if there be no such organization, same shall revert to the City of San Antonio, Texas, for the use of the Public Library; and in the event at such time the said City of San Antonio is unable or unwilling to accept such distribution, or is not at the time a qualified donee, such remaining assets shall be distributed for charitable purposes.
