Dear Dr. Boyd:

We have determined that Friends of the San Antonio Public Library, Inc., Taxpayer No. 1-74-6063442-5, qualifies for exemption from state franchise tax and state sales tax. In the event that we have reason to believe that it no longer qualifies for the exemptions, we will notify the registered agent that the exempt status is under review. The franchise tax exemption as a 501(c)(3) organization is effective April 3, 1964.

Our records show that the corporate charter was forfeited by the Secretary of State on June 9, 1992, because the franchise tax was not paid. Even though the corporation is now exempt from paying the tax, the Secretary of State requires that the enclosed application for reinstatement and a copy of this letter be filed with them.

This corporation also qualifies for exemption from the state and local sales taxes effective the date of this letter as a 501(c)(3) organization. It may now issue an exemption certificate in lieu of the sales tax on taxable items if they relate to the purpose of the exempt organization and are not used for the personal benefit of a private stockholder or individual. The certificate does not require a number to be valid and may be reproduced in any quantity.

If the organization changes its name, Registered Agent or address, it is required to notify the Secretary of State.
